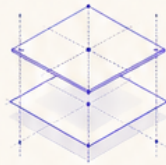


## THE COMPANY

Panovia is an AI-native coordination and knowledge platform purpose-built for the Architecture, Engineering and Construction sector.

It operates as the agent layer above project records, regulatory submissions and audit-bearing work product.

The first beta cohort opens to invited firms on 8 June 2026 across the United Kingdom, United States, United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia and Turkey.



## THE MOMENT

The architectural conversation in AI has converged across four arguments in the last twelve weeks.

Y Combinator's Summer 2026 Requests for Startups named the Company Brain as a structured layer above raw data. Palantir entered AEC with an enterprise decision layer thesis. Egnyte made the same data-foundation argument at the AEC vertical level. Graphisoft, writing in AEC Magazine, named accountability anchored in human professionals as the regulatory direction.

AEC firms working under regimes like the UK Building Safety Act 2022, the BSR Gateway 2 review, ISO 19650, MoHRE compliance and Vision 2030 frameworks now need the architectural answer that holds across these four conversations.



## THE ARCHITECTURE

Panovia commits to three architectural properties, holding from the first line of code.

- ✓ Citation at source, page and revision.
- ✓ Human approval on every external action.
- ✓ Surfaced uncertainty rather than collapsed.

The build of this commitment is what Panovia calls **Human-to-Agent-to-Human Governance**.

The commitments are architectural rather than configurable, holding under audit interrogation by design.

3. Why regulated industries are becoming the next test case for AI governance, and what AEC can teach the rest of the economy.

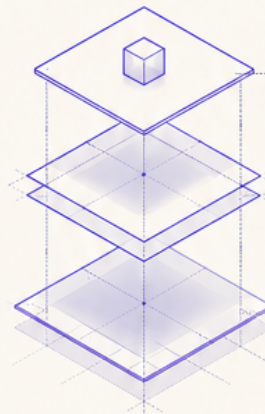
